Looking for work can be a challenging task for anyone, even when you are job ready. MOSAIC's Refugee Employment Support Services can help make you more effective in your job search by providing individual employment counselling to help you prepare and enter the Canadian labour market.

How does it work?

You will get one-on-one counselling sessions with our experienced staff and learn about:

- Resume building
- Identifying soft skills
- Canadian labour market information
- Job search strategies
- Interview preparation
- Job maintenance

You will receive:

- Employer specific information
- Access to job postings and employer partners
- Referrals for additional supports
- Hiring events and job fairs

Who can join?

- A refugee with a permanent resident status
- A protected person (under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, S.C. 2001. C 27) with valid work permit
- A person under the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET)
- Has English level equivalent to a minimum of CLB 5
