Building Service Worker Training Program





The Building Service Worker Training (BSW) is a free program for Spanish speaking individuals who meet the eligibility criteria and want to start a career as a building service worker.

Participants complete 7 weeks of essential skills, language skills, and occupational skills training. This is followed by 3 weeks of on-the-job work experience with local employers. After, participants receive 2 weeks of job search support and follow up.

The program gives the skills, knowledge, and experience needed to enter the building service field!



Who Can Join

This program is open to individuals who meet the following criteria:

- Approved by WorkBC
- Unemployed
- Must be on EI OR have had a claim in the last 5 years OR have earned more than \$2,000 in insurable earnings and paid employee El premiums on those earnings in at least 5 of the last 10 years OR A British Columbia Employment and Assistance Client (BCEA)
- Spanish speaking
- English at CLB 4/5+
- Commit to 7 weeks of in-person training and a 3-week work placement
- Either a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Refugee (protected person) with a valid work permit
- Living in the Metro Vancouver area
